Criteria

- Academic excellence: Minimum 80% Aggregate in Grade 6, with a minimum of 80% in English and Mathematics.
- Active involvement in school and/or community, showing evidence of the ability to take initiative, seek out and make the most of opportunities, accept responsibility and give back gracefully.
- Demonstrate financial need by completing and returning the DSG Financial Assistance Form and supporting documentation, which will be forwarded on receipt of the scholarship application.
- South African Citizen.
- Candidates must write the DSG Scholarship examination.

What the Scholarship covers

- Tuition, levies, and boarding fees from Grade 8 to 12
- Entrance fee is waived

¹As defined by the B-BBEE Amendment Act of 2013, 'black' in this context is a generic term which includes African, Coloured and Indian persons who are citizens of the Republic of South Africa by birth or descent.

DSG EN AVANT SCHOLARSHIP

This Scholarship is awarded to an exceptional all-rounder, who shows the potential to be a positive role model in the school environment.

Criteria

- Academic excellence: Minimum 80% Aggregate in Grade 6, with a minimum of 80% in English and Mathematics.
- Active involvement in school and/or community, showing evidence of the ability to take initiative, seek out and make the most of opportunities, accept responsibility and give back gracefully.
- Demonstrate talent in an extra-curricular activity.
- South African Citizen.
- Candidates must write the DSG Scholarship examination.

What the Scholarship covers

- 75% of tuition and boarding fees from Grade 8 to 12
- Entrance fee is waived
- Extras and levies to be covered by parents/guardians

DSG ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria

- Academic excellence: Minimum 80% Aggregate in Grade 6, with a minimum of 80% in English and Mathematics.
- Candidates must write the DSG Scholarship examination.

- 10 % of tuition fees from Grade 8 to 12
